FINDING ARTISTS WITH What3Words

Each artist entry includes a unique three-word address from *What3Words*. This pinpoints the exact location of their studio. To use it:

- 1. Go to the *What3Words* website or open the app.
- 2. Enter the three words exactly as printed (including full stops).
- 3. Select the correct result to view the precise location on the map.
- 4. Tap 'Navigate' to choose your preferred directions app, such as *Google Maps* or *Apple Maps*, and follow the route to the studio.

Using *What3Words* ensures you arrive at the right place, even in hard-to-find locations.

If you wish to take photographs of artists' work or studios, please do check with the artists first.

Pentlands Open Studios is a collective of professional artists whose studios are united by their location near the upper valley of the Water of Leith, Edinburgh’s principal river, and its adjoining walkways. Nestled in the southwest of the city at the foot of the Pentland Hills, the artists work across a wide range of media and craft disciplines.

Our Art Trail hosts 12 venues, consisting of 8 artist studios and 4 community exhibition spaces. There is a total of 25 artists and makers, including our invited artists, participating in the trail. Please refer to the detailed map pages and the individual artist listings for exact studio and venue address locations and relevant access information.

HILLS AND WATERWHEELS

Pentlands Open Studios use branding imagery derived from, and inspired by, our proximity to the Pentland Hills and the many waterwheels which used to power the mills on the Water of Leith. At one time there were over 70 mills on the Water of Leith, 12 of which were in our area of the upper valley.

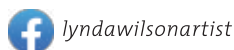
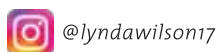

THE ART TRAIL MAP



FOLLOW THE TRAIL

Our Art Trail is approximately 4 miles in distance from NTS Malleny Garden in Balerno to the studios in Colinton, by road or walkway. Located within such a small area, it is possible to visit all of the 12 studios/venues in one day. The trail can be taken in any direction and it can be joined at any point. There is no specific direction of travel to be followed.



WALKING AND CYCLING

Part of the charm of the Art Trail is that it borders the Water of Leith and for the more energetic, the path along its banks offers a scenic cycling or walking route, with access via paths and tracks to the various studio locations.



ENJOYING THE EXPERIENCE

Most studios do not have public toilet facilities. There are many hospitality venues such as café's and public houses throughout the area, which can offer such facilities.

SPYLAW PARK

Visit Spylaw Park where Colinton Tunnel and CVE invite you to *Creating in the Park* – help paint the tunnel mural, enjoy live entertainment, or simply relax in the sunshine.

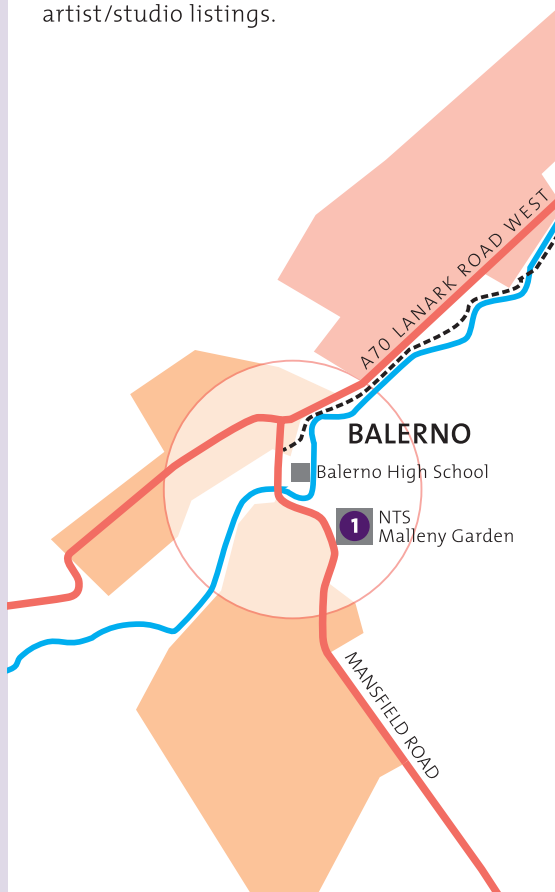

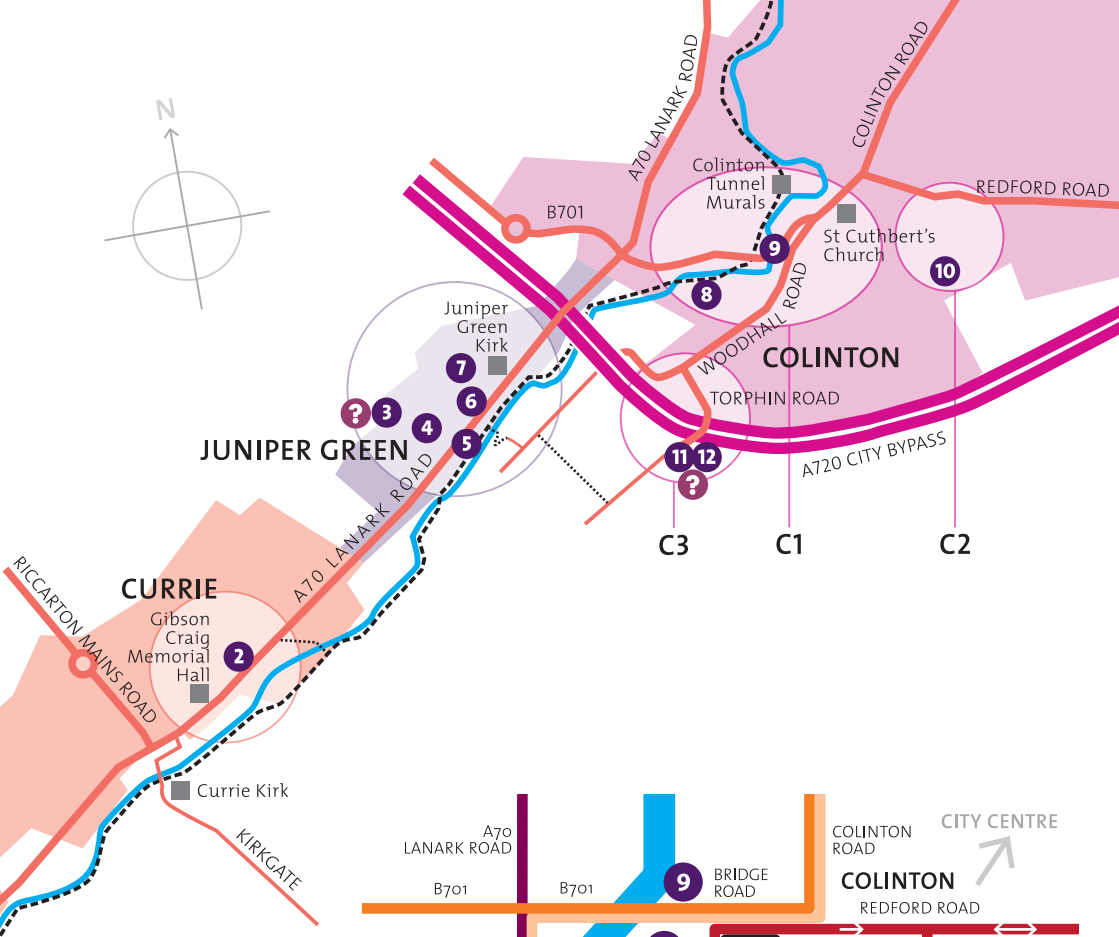

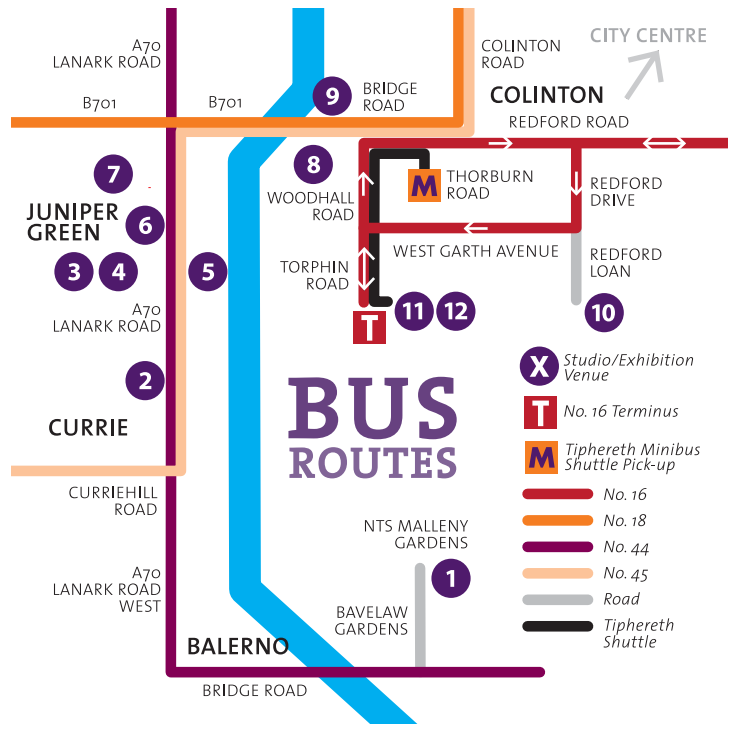

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

POPUP CAFÉS

Venues 3 and 12 plan to open pop-up cafés to enable visitors to enjoy a refreshment break during their art trail journey. The charities *Community for Food* in Juniper Green Village Hall and *Tiphereth Camphill* will organise and run these temporary facilities.



COLINTON – TIPHERETH FREE MINIBUS SHUTTLE

Tiphereth are running a free minibus shuttle from Thorburn Road in Colinton to both of our Tiphereth venues (nos 11 & 12) off Woodhall Road. This will be a direct hourly return service, departing Thorburn Road on the hour and returning from Tiphereth.



FREE E-BIKE RICKSHAW

We plan to run a free 'two-person' electric bike rickshaw service on the scenic walkway alongside the Water of Leith, stopping at Balerno, Currie and Juniper Green. Please refer to our website for more information.

INFORMATION HUBS & VOLUNTEERS

Two hubs will be located along the Art Trail (venues 3 and 12 on our map) where visitors can speak with volunteers, pick up our essential guide booklets, and find out more about the event. We have a team of volunteers wearing branded orange hi-viz vests, who can offer way-finding advice along the trail.



You may also hear live music from a solo classical oud player who will be moving between, and performing at, these venues.



PARKING

Most of our studios are in artists' homes with no dedicated parking. On-street parking is easily available on the side streets adjoining studios and venues, but be aware that the immediate area around a studio will get busy over the Art Trail weekend. The major arterial roads will have limited parking areas, so please ensure that you park considerately. There are dedicated public car parks for visitors at NTS Malleny Gardens, Balerno, and at Tiphereth in Colinton.
